- In these verses, what did Peter accuse these people of doing?
- *How could Peter and John be so bold to say these things?*

**Read together Acts 3:17-20**

- What does Peter tell these Jews they need to do? (Repent & turn to God)

**Read together Acts 4:1-22**

- How important is this message of salvation today?
- What keeps you from being as bold as Peter and John?

**Three M's:**

1. Message—Only in Jesus is salvation & life; just repent and turn to God.
2. Miracles—God's power was at work to help proclaim the message.
3. Motivation—Everyone needs to hear this good news!
